INSTRUCTIONS – Domestic Corporation Annual Renewal

Annual Filing Service Fee: \$95 (Active Status) (\$150 for expedited service – 24 hour turn around time)

Reinstatement Service Fee: \$170 (Inactive Status) (\$225 for expedited service – 24 hour turn around time)

All business corporations governed under Chapter 302A/319B are required to file an Annual Renewal once every calendar year.

Items 3 and 4 are filed within the articles of incorporation; if there is a change to this information you must amend your articles of incorporation. The amendment form along with the \$80 fee* must be submitted at the same time as your annual renewal. You cannot use the Annual Renewal form to make changes to the articles of incorporation. Items 5 through 8 can be changed once a year by filing your Annual Renewal form.

PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT LEGIBLY IN BLACK INK.

1. **File Number:** Provide the original corporate file number issued by the MN Secretary of State. PDR can provide this if needed.
2. **Governed under the Laws of the State of:** This form is to be filed only if the state of incorporation is Minnesota.
3. **Corporate Name:** (Required) List the corporate name on file with the Secretary of State's office. If changes to the corporate name are necessary an Amendment form and an \$80* fee must be included with the Annual Renewal.
4. **Registered Agent, if any and Registered Office Address:** (Required) If changes to the registered agent name or address are necessary an Amendment form and \$80* fee must be included with the Annual Renewal.
5. **Principal Executive Office Address:** (Required) A full street address or rural route and rural route box number is required for filing the Annual Renewal. A post office box alone is not acceptable.
6. **Name and Business Address of Chief Executive Officer:** (Required) Fill in the name and complete business address of the Chief Executive Officer or other person who carries out the functions as C.E.O. of the corporation.
7. **Name, daytime telephone number and e-mail address of contact person for the corporation:** Please list a name, daytime telephone number and an e-mail address of a person who can be contacted about this form.
8. **Does the corporation own, lease, or have any financial interest in agricultural land or land capable of being farmed?.** Check Yes or No. Entities that own, lease, or have any financial interest in agricultural land or land capable of being farmed must register with the MN Dept. of Agriculture's Corporate Farm Program.

A business corporation that has been statutorily dissolved by the MN Secretary of State's office may retroactively reinstate its existence by filing the current year's renewal and paying a statutory reinstatement and PDR processing fee of \$170. For your convenience, the MN Secretary of State does provide standard forms for most filings. For an additional \$55 fee, you may request expedited services to file at the MN Secretary of State through PDR which covers statutory and expediting fees.
